# Staff Proposed Process for Election of Public Board Member

1.

An opportunity will be provided for Board Members to make any comments they wish.

2.

Staff will hand out ballots to Board Members, and Board Members will note their first, second, and third choices for the Public Board Member.

3.

Counsel will collect the ballots and determines if any candidate has received at least five votes for first choice. If so, that candidate has received a majority of votes and is therefore selected as the Public Board Member.

# Staff Proposed Process for Election of Public Board Member *(continued)*

4.

If no candidate has received a majority for first place, Counsel will work with the Clerk to display the first, second, and third place rankings for the seven candidates for the Board and public to see.

5.

The Board will then review the rankings and discuss.

6.

A Board Member may make a motion to select a candidate to be the Public Board Member (with a vote if the motion is seconded), or a Board Member may propose a second round of balloting.

# Staff Proposed Process for Election of Public Board Member *(continued)*

7.

Step number 6 will be repeated until a candidate is elected by a majority of the Board Members.

8.

If the selected candidate is present, the candidate will be seated immediately.
