Kathy Miller was elected to the Board of Supervisors in June 2014, sworn in on January 5, 2015 and elected chairperson of the board, serving for 2015.

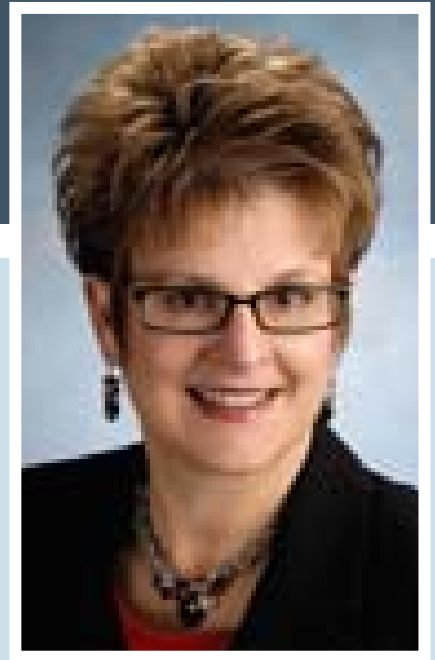
She currently represents San Joaquin County in many capacities, including the San Joaquin Council of Governments, the San Joaquin General Hospital Health Care Services Review project, Hospital Joint Conference Committee, Medical Executive Committee and Health Plan of San Joaquin. In addition, she represents the County as a Trustee of the San Joaquin County Employees Retirement Association. Kathy continues her leadership on regional water issues with the Five Delta Counties Coalition, the San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency, Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy and as Chair of the San Joaquin Delta Coalition.

In 2017, Supervisor Miller leads two, countywide task forces for the Board – the Homelessness Task Force and the Children & Youth Task Force – which include representatives from service providers, county departments and each of the cities.

Prior to her election to the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors, Supervisor Miller served on the Stockton City Council, 2009 – 2014, with four of those years as Vice Mayor, and emerged as a strong voice for fiscal responsibility and open, transparent and accountable local government.

During her eight years as an elected official, Miller has also represented Stockton residents on the Delta Protection Commission, Stockton Convention & Visitor's Bureau and the Library & Literacy Foundation of San Joaquin. In addition, she has held leadership positions on the Northeastern San Joaquin County Groundwater Banking Authority and rose to the rank of Second Vice President of the state-wide League of California Cities.

Kathy Miller and her husband, Karl, have been married 39 years, have three grown children and two grandchildren. She has lived in Stockton since 1997, owning and operating her own interior design business.
