Biography

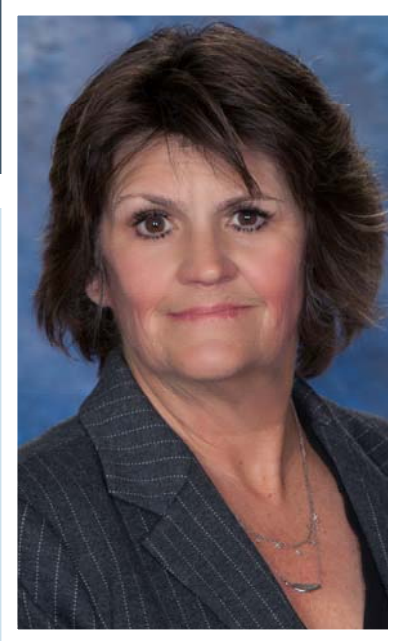
