Serving on the SJAFCA Board requires you to annually file a Fair Political Practices Commission Statement of Economic Interest (FPPC Form 700), a public document in which you disclose your financial interests. The law and ethics prohibit Board Members from participating in and voting on matters in which they may have a direct/indirect financial interest. Are there any potential conflicts which may develop from your occupation or other financial interests in relation to your responsibilities as a member of the SJAFCA Board?
