



Smith Canal Gate Project
Draft Environmental Impact Report

The San Joaquin Area Flood Control Agency (SJAFCA) is proposing the Smith Canal Gate Project (project), near the mouth of Smith Canal, adjacent to the San Joaquin River, to reduce area flood risk. The project would construct a fixed wall with a gate-type structure to isolate the canal from the San Joaquin River during high flow and tide events, reducing flood risk for approximately 8,000 properties and 24,000 people. Anyone interested in commenting on the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for this project is encouraged to do so.
